Among local Native American tribes, the Mdewakanton are the most disenfranchised; our community has been blessed to build a friendship with them. This year, we again raised \$1000 of assistance for the tribe. We also give them monthly financial support. • In addition to maintaining a small food shelf in Eagan, St. Elizabeth parishioners continue to be extremely active in Focus Minnesota. • Monthly financial support of the Minneapolis Peace House, a community of Catholic nuns and 30-40 volunteers from the Twin Cities metropolitan area who commit to the service of the poor and homeless. |
