Highlights of Top Three Activities

- Our Kansas City Youth Camp (EOYC), led by Fr. Christopher Rowe, hosted His Grace, Bishop Paul in July. Nearly 100 youth from around the Midwest and 40 counselors attended. The camp focused on Champions of the Faith.
- Fr. Timothy Sawchak was able to take a 4-month sabbatical made possible by the Lily Foundation Clergy Renewal Grant.
- A number of activities in the life of the parish have grown in size and participation. Those activities include a redesigned Friday Night Meal program, a Saturday Morning with the Saints women's group and others.

Outreach and Charitable Activities

- We prepare and serve a meal to the hungry at Reconciliation Services in Kansas City, MO once a month. We provide over 175 meals each month.
- Collections are taken throughout the year to help those affected by tragedies or other difficult situations. We also support the many Orthodox Mission organizations like IOCC, Project Mexico, and OCMC. IOCC is supported by Souper Bowl Sunday in February, all children receive OCMC coin boxes at Great Lent and we built over 200 School Kits for IOCC in August.
- Monthly financial support is given to our Missions in Rolla, MO and Lawrence, KS and also to Reconciliation Ministries in Kansas City, MO.

Major Challenges Faced

- Lack of meeting space and classroom space as the number of children in our church school program continues to grow.
- Parishioners living a great distance from the church

- The parish is participating in a project to archive and preserve parish records from our inception. Funding is coming from National Endowment for the Humanities and the Kansas Humanities Council
- Our 100th Anniversary committee is beginning work for our celebration in October 2017. Events will be occurring throughout 2017.
- The next phase of our iconography project will be installed
