

2017 Chancellor's Report – V. Rev. John Zdinak

The Chancellor's Report to the Diocesan Assembly was for the most part delivered orally. The following information was read aloud and is posted here for the record.

Christ the Savior Church, Chicago, Illinois Property Expenditures Updated Oct 2017

- 1.Flat roof, \$8,000 (2013)
- 2.Courtyard, \$18,000 (2014)
- 3.Tuck pointing, \$22,000 (2016/ 2017)
- 4.Nave Windows, \$47,000 (2016)
- 5.Residence and Church Remodeling \$60,000 (2007-2015)
 - 1st floor kitchen stairway
 - 3rd floor bathroom
 - church basement (church school rooms, storage and archive room)
 - enclosing residence back stairway for storage
- 6.Iconography, \$160,000 (2009-2015)

7. and let us not forget, the iconostasis \$40,000 (twice thanks to ABJ and Zacchaeus)
8. Altar windows 2016/2017 (\$10,000)
9. Boiler upgrades- traps and insulation, \$2,100.00 (2016)

We had our annual meeting in September and it was approved to fix the four dormers on the church (\$11K) and also to strip, paint, seal and cover with lexon the large stained glass window on the north side of the building (facing the courtyard). The current estimate is \$13K.
