This concert is being held to benefit Petr Gudkov – Sretensky Choir Soloist battling Stage IV Hodgkin  
Lymphoma.

37-year-old father of two Petr Gudkov, soloist and core member of the acclaimed Sretensky Monastery  
Choir of Moscow for more than 10 years, remained in Chicago following the choir's concert at  
Symphony Center this past October. Afflicted with Stage 4 Hodgkin's Lymphoma, he is looking for a  
chance to live, but his needs overwhelmingly exceed his resources. Through the resourcefulness and  
generosity of the Russian and Pan-Orthodox communities in North America and abroad, Petr has been  
undergoing chemotherapy and new treatments here in the US that have made him stronger and now –  
a candidate for a bone marrow transplant. The costs are expected to exceed \$150,000.

This concert is a chance to return a favor to a choir that has enriched our spiritual lives during their two  
international tours (2007 and 2012) that included visits to Chicago. In addition, the Sretensky Choir  
has been a great friend and benefactor to suffering Serbian people over the years. The proceeds of their  
two international tours, exceeding \$450,000, benefitted Kosovo soup kitchens.
