The Question of Baptism in Ecumenical Relationships

Baptism has long been and should be a source of unity among Christians, but difficulties have sometimes arisen. Bishop Alexander will draw upon sound historical theology and our shared tradition to help remove some of the roadblocks on the path to unity between the Orthodox, Catholics and other Christians.

The Right Reverend Alexander Golitzin has served as Bishop of Toledo and the Bulgarian Diocese for the Orthodox Church in America since 2012. Bishop Alexander received a Bachelor of Arts degree in English from the University of California at Berkeley and a Master of Divinity degree from Saint Vladimir's Seminary. After receiving his D.Phil. from Oxford, he accepted a position

in the theology department at Marquette University, where he taught for over 20 years. Ordained in 1982, he has served the Orthodox Church in America in a variety of capacities, including serving at Saints Cyril and Methodius Church in Milwaukee, WI, while teaching at Marquette.
