SPIRITUALITY—New Course, Starting December/January

Professor: Fr. Elijah Mueller

This is the introductory course in the St. Macrina curriculum cycle of 7 courses. Students learn about the basics of Orthodox spirituality through important patristic texts. These texts will explain traditional scriptural interpretation and teach the ascetic theology of the Church. Through these, students will learn to apply scriptural and liturgical images to our inner life, and identify the virtues and passions as described by the great teachers of the Church. This course is a formational foundation of the program, helping us to inculcate the right virtues and the practice of prayer that supports the whole curriculum. Learning about "ascesis" helps to prepare the students to have the right frame of mind for further study of theological subjects that follow in the curriculum.
