And be aware that, at my request, our seminarians gather at each seminary at least once a month to sing the Akathist to the Mother of God of *Tikhvin*, asking God's blessing upon all of you through the intercession of the Holy Mother of God. They also pray for you as part of their daily rule of prayer.
- Live the Orthodox Faith! We help our seminarians—and one another—by living our Faith in our families, at school, at work, and in all our relationships. This is our shared calling by which we live the Gospel and bring Christ into the world each and every day.

Again, thank you for your kind and thoughtful generosity. Our seminarians are faithful Orthodox Christians who hope to one day serve in the parishes of our beloved Diocese, that is, they hope one day to serve you, your families, and all your loved ones.
